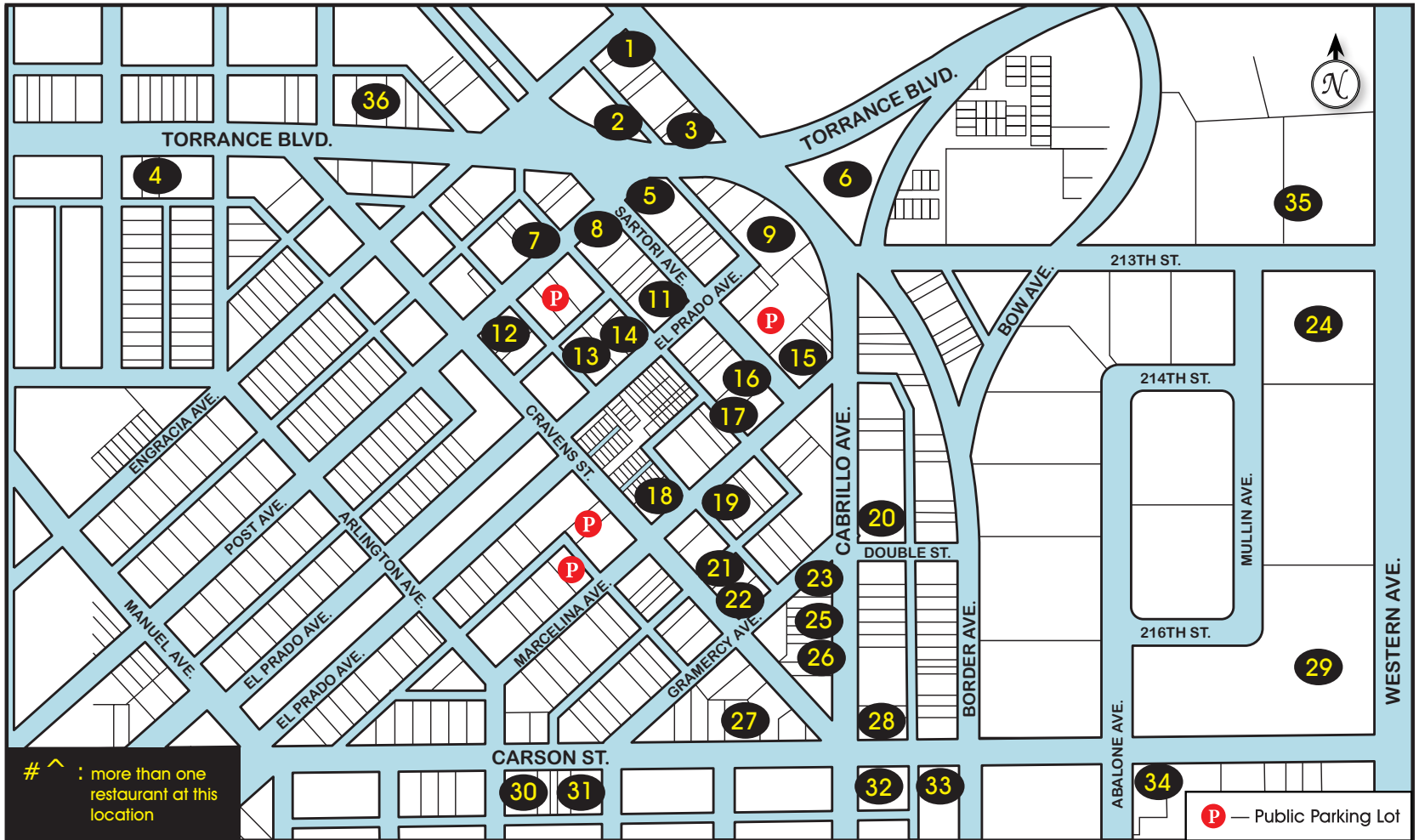

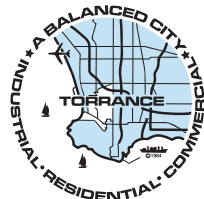
Torrance 1912-
