**General Information**

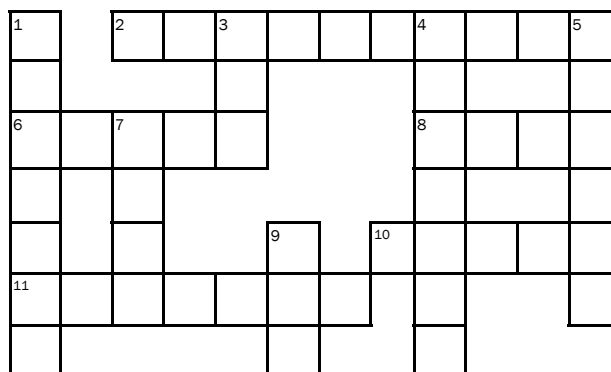
THE ATTIC is a place for high school students to get away from their everyday routines; a place that is committed to their voice and needs. The center is a drop-in program for 14-18 year-olds in the City of Torrance. The students must be Torrance residents or attend a Torrance high school. The programs are organized and implemented by high school students with adult supervision. Students have unique opportunities to plan and participate in special events, classes, activities, volunteerism, fitness, sports and much more.

THE ATTIC is an 8,000 square foot facility containing every type of necessary equipment and furniture that helps a student wind down after a long day. The front doors open to a large living room setting complete with comfy, overstuffed couches, colorful chairs, stereo system, pool table, foosball, big screen TV, video games and a full service cafe! It's the perfect place for everyone!

THE ATTIC'S mission is to provide all Torrance high school students with a variety of recreational, academic, vocational and self-help programs, in an environment safely away from drugs, alcohol and gangs.
